

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-01
CITY OF ORR
AN ORDINANCE OPTING OUT OF
THE REQUIREMENTS OF
MINNESOTA STATUTES, SECTION 462.3593

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2016, Governor Dayton signed into law the creation and regulation of temporary family health care dwellings, codified at Minn. Stat. Section 462.3593, which permit and regulate temporary family health care dwellings;

WHEREAS, subdivision 9 of Minn. Stat. Sec. 462.3593 allows cities to "opt out" of those regulations;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Orr, ordains as follows:

CITY OF ORR ZONING ORDINANCE 1978-01 IS AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

OPT-OUT OF MINNESOTA STATUTES, SECTION 462.3593: Pursuant to authority granted by Minnesota Statutes, Section 462.3593, subdivision 9, the City of Orr opts-out of the requirements of Minn. Stat. Sec. 462.3593, which defines and regulates Temporary Family Health Care Dwellings.

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and publication.
